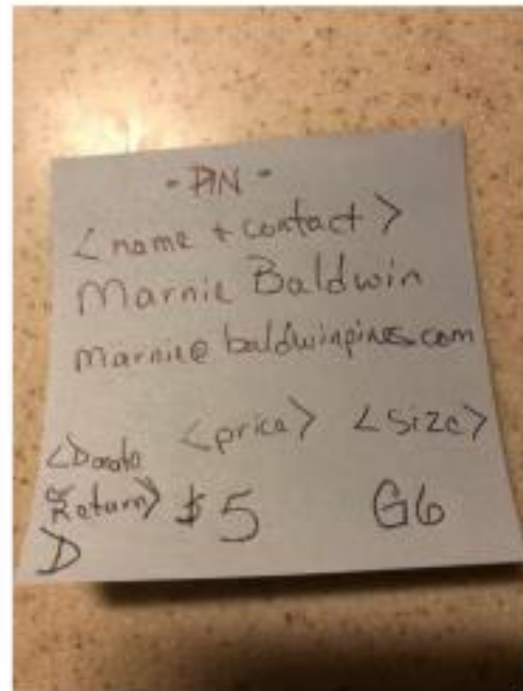

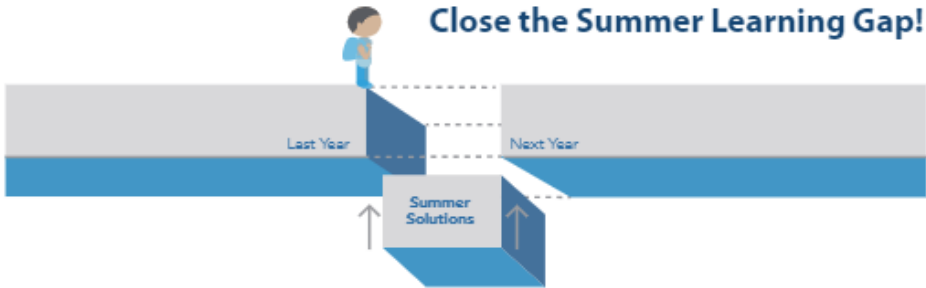

Consignors will need to sign in and **must** submit all clean garments on hangers with a 3x5 card attached to each garment with your name, contact information, size and price.
