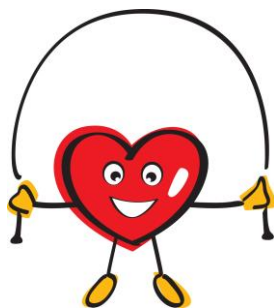

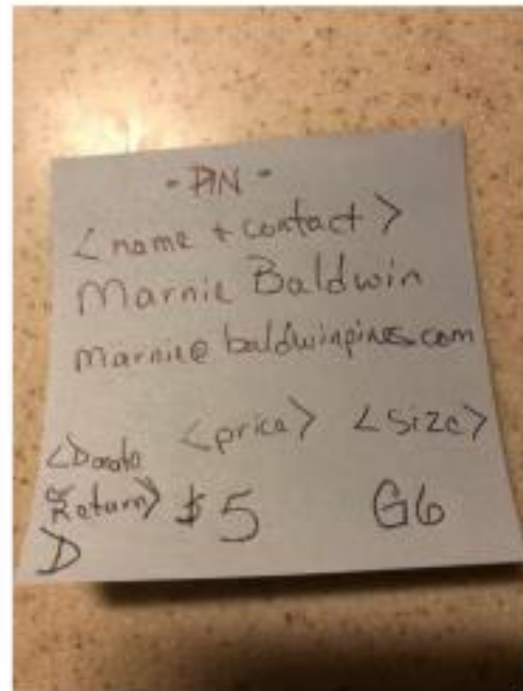


# Mid-Year Used Uniform Sale 2019

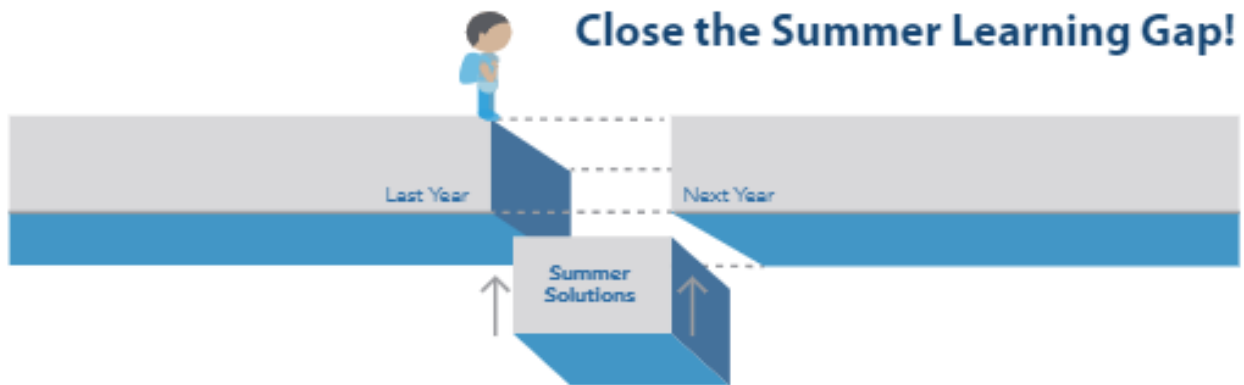
Those wishing to consign items into the sale need to drop off all items at the front desk on Friday, March 8 during normal school hours. Consignors will need to sign in and **must** submit all clean garments on hangers with a 3x5 card attached to each garment with your name, contact information, size and price. You will also need to indicate whether your items are to be returned (R) or donated (D) to the PTO closet after the sale. (See example below). Please note that all consignments will be assessed a 25% fee on all items sold to benefit the PTO. We are looking for volunteers to help during set up and during the sales.
