so excited about Holy Spirit's Talent Show!

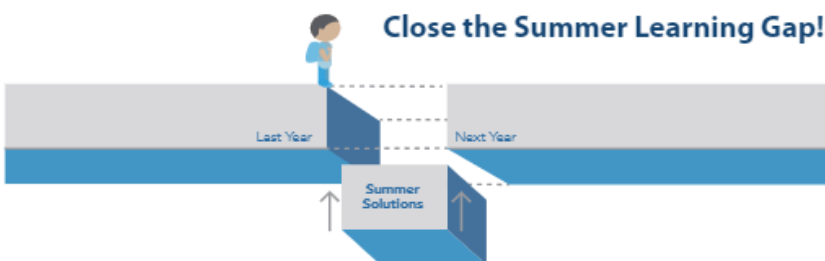
We will have a variety of talent displayed
