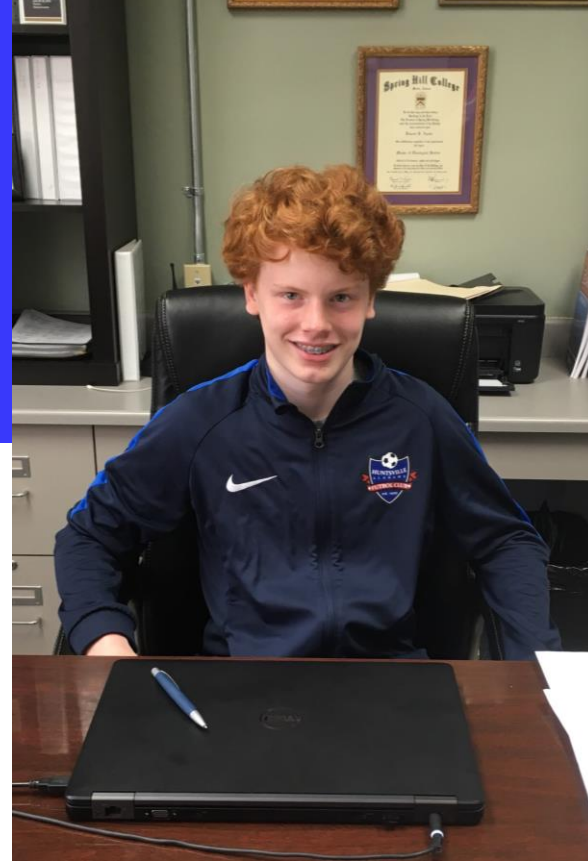

Do you have a heart for service this Lenten season?

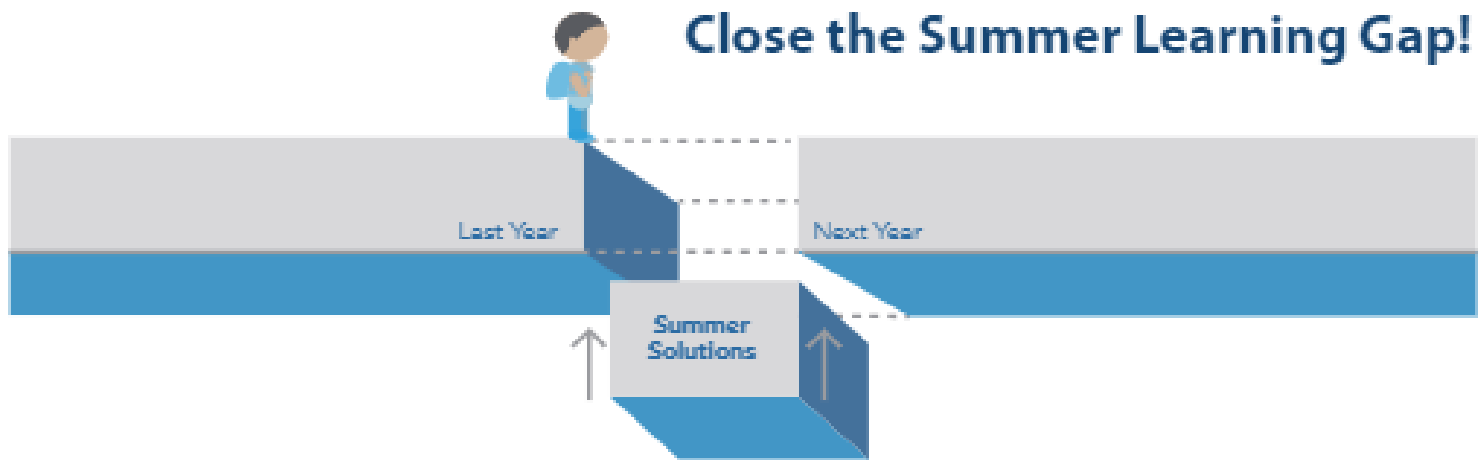
The PTO is sponsoring the day and we need your help.

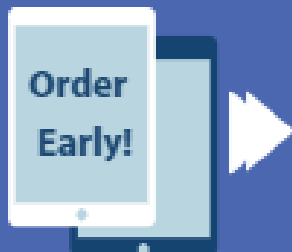
