



Parent(s) Code of Ethical Conduct

A cooperative relationship between the Holy Spirit Regional Catholic School personnel and a parent/guardian is essential for the overall education of a student. It is critical that a cooperative relationship be maintained through constructive dialogue with the parent/guardian.

All parents/guardians are expected to:

- Recognize that the education of children is a joint responsibility of the parents and the school community.
- Know school and classroom rules and help their children understand them. Convey to their children a supportive attitude toward education and the school.
- Build good relationships with teachers, other parents and their children's friends.
- Help their children deal effectively with peer pressure.
- Inform school officials of changes in the home situation that may affect student conduct or performance.
- Adhere to the same standards of respect as students and staff in regards to their interactions with administrators, teachers, staff and students.
- Maintain a professional, respectful demeanor while using social media regarding the school, staff, and/or administration; including, but not limited to, Facebook®, Instagram®, Twitter®, SnapChat®.
- Review the Parent/Student Handbook with their child and sign it.

Public Conduct on School Property

Schools are a place of work and learning. Certain limits are set for parents and other citizens who visit our schools and classrooms. All persons on school property or attending a school function shall conduct themselves in a respectful and orderly manner. The building principal or his/her designee is responsible for all persons in the building and on the grounds. The following rules apply to visitors to the schools:

Anyone who is not a regular staff member or student of the school will be considered a visitor. All visitors to the school must report to the front reception area upon arrival at the school. They will be required to sign the visitor/volunteer register and will be issued a visitor/volunteer badge/sticker, which must be worn at all times while in the school or on school grounds. The visitor must return the badge/sticker to the front reception area and sign out before leaving the building. Visitors attending after school functions that are open to the public, such as parent-teacher organization meetings or public gatherings, are not required to register. Official school hours are 7:30am-3:30pm.

Parents or citizens who wish to observe a classroom while school is in session are required to arrange such visits with the classroom teacher(s) and school principal, so that class disruption is kept to a minimum.
